The only prayer made in the petition is to decide the various complaints/representations submitted by the petitioner. In substance, the petitioner claims that certain illegal appointments as Group B, Group C and Group D are being made by the respondents. From the reading of the petition, it is evident that the petitioner has filed the writ petition for an alleged public cause. In these circumstances, the petitioner, as per the rules, is required to indicate that the writ petition is in the nature of public interest litigation. The petitioner has also not asserted as to how he is adversely affected.

It is evident that prima facie the writ petition has been cleverly drafted to indulge in the bench hunting. Hence, while refusing to entertain such a writ petition, the State Government is directed to look into the matter and proceed accordingly.
