The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to call upon the record of the Ludhiana District BSNL Employees Co-op U.S.E. T/C Society Limited and declaring the resolutions passed by the Managing Committee, which are violative of Rule 80 of the Punjab Cooperative Societies Rules, 1963, as also the election of the office bearers conducted in the meeting, as illegal.

At the very outset, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that in this regard, the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 10.09.2022, Annexure P-4, upon all the respondents herein, but no action has been taken thereon till date. Counsel would submit that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the said legal notice is decided in a time bound manner, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. Deepanjay Sharma, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be supplied to him during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to decide legal notice dated 10.09.2022, Annexure P-4, of the petitioner within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees Welfare Fund.
