By means of this writ petition filed under Article 226 Constitution of India petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to evaluate the OMR sheets of the petitioners for the post of Head Constable (Ministerial), as per advertisement dated 05.12.2016 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the parties are not at conflict that the dispute raised in the writ petition was also the subject matter before Delhi High Court in W.P.(C) 8318 of 2017 (Annexure R-1/2), wherein vide order dated 06.03.2018, the claims of similarly situated persons were dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the above decision, he does not press this writ petition and prays for withdrawal.
