The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0067 dated 17.07.2022 registered under Sections 484, 485 IPC (later on deleted) and Section 506, 500 IPC and Sections 384/385 IPC added later on, at Police Station Bhagwanpur, District Rupnagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 13.03.2023 by way of an affidavit of Tarlochan Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar, District Rupnagar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record He on instructions from ASI Jeet Ram admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 18.08.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

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joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
