The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 07.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) whereby respondent No.4 has been transferred from Ropar Range, Ropar to Patiala Range, Patiala despite pendency of criminal complaints and writ petition against him.

The grievance espoused for raising challenge to the aforesaid posting order was that as per the Transfer Policy, a person, against whom vigilance inquiry is ending, cannot be posted at a public dealing seat.

Reply by way of affidavit of Satnam Kaur, Under Secretary to Government of Punjab, Department of Excise and Taxation, Punjab has been filed today in Court. Copy thereof has been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is specifically mentioned in the said reply that no such vigilance inquiry was pending against respondent No.4 as on the date of order of posting.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
