The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.303 dated 22.09.2022, under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC (Sections 467, 468 and 471 of IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Division-B, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar .

Vide order dated 05.01.2023 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 05.01.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI – Roop Lal has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 05.01.2023 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
