Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having GD No.21 dated 1.5.2022 under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25/27 of Arms Act at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural) arising out of FIR No.59 dated 29.4.2022 registered under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act.at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural).

Vide order dated 24.11.2022, the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join investigation, after taking into consideration the fact that the case involves version as well as cross-version and further the

petitioner was not named in the FIR and later on nominated as an accused on the basis of statement of Sakater Singh which was recorded after 3 months of the occurrence.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of previous order of interim bail passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Bikramjit Singh apprised the Court that the petitioner has joined investigation and recovery of weapon used in the commission of offence has been effected. State counsel further submitted that the petitioner is not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 24.11.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
