MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed for directing the respondents to get the treatment of petitioner done from Civil Hospital, Faridkot or any other hospital.

2. In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, response by way of affidavit dated 29.11.2023 of Sh. Rajiv Kumar Arora, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot has been filed along with the medical report dated 28.11.2023 (R/T-1) and for reference, the same reads as under:-

“With reference to above cited subject and on the basis of medical assessment, and perusal of his available medical record, it is hereby submitted:-

1. *That the said inmate, aged 72, is medically assessed today and found to be medically stable. He reported breathlessness on exertion and chest pain since last six months. Further, he reports of difficulty in passing urine and abdominal pain.*

2. *That he has been investigated for above complaints by specialist doctors of GGS MC and Hospital Faridkot and provided*

treatment for the same. He went for ultrasound abdomen on dated 11.11.2023 with no significant findings.

3. *That there is nothing in his medical record to indicate that he ever needed any surgical treatment for his ailments. Further, the services of specialist doctors on OPD basis were regularly available through monthly medical camps.*

4. *That as part of his heart evaluation, his Coronary angiography and echocardiography is scheduled for 06/12/2023.”*

Perusal of the above extract clearly reveals that petitioner was examined by the Specialist Doctor of GGS MC & Hospital, Faridkot; but, after going through the findings, nothing was found to suggest that he ever needed any surgical treatment.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed off.

4. However, Jail authorities are directed to take care of the health of petitioner in view of para 4 of the aforesaid report regarding his examination for angiography and echocardiography on 06.12.2023.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
