The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of direction to the official respondent nos.1 to 4 to take necessary legal/appropriate action against respondent nos.5 to 8 on the basis of the Fir No.25 dated 30.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) filed by the petitioner /complainant under Sections 307, 324, 323, 506 and Section 34 ICP P.S. Khushi Khera, District Fazilka.

The Counsel for the State has filed reply by way of affidavit dated 26.11.2023 of Mr. Subhag Singh, DSP, Sub Division Fazilka in court today, which is taken on record. As per the said reply respondent nos.6 & 7 have been found to be innocent and Section 307 IPC stands deleted. The report under Section 173(2) Cr.PC shall be submitted under Sections 325 and 326 IPC after the accused are arrested.

As regards the prayer for protection of the life and liberty of the

petitioner/complainant is concerned, she is at liberty to move an appropriate application before the concerned Authority stating therein that she requires protection for which is ready to make requisite charges and in case the said application is moved the same shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

For every other prayer, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the Trial Court by way of appropriate petition.

The petition stands disposed of with aforesaid directions.
