AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No. 574 dated 30.10.2020 registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court at the appropriate stage. He, however, prays that the trial Court be directed to grant exemption from personal appearance to the petitioner who is a lady aged 50 years and a resident of Delhi. She is, however, ready to furnish an undertaking by way of an affidavit to appear before the trial Court on the dates, for which her presence is absolutely necessary.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. However, if the petitioner files an application for grant of exemption from personal appearance, the same shall be considered sympathetically, in accordance with law, keeping in view the aforesaid facts.
