The instant criminal writ petition has been filed for seeking release of the petitioner on parole for a period of six weeks to enable him to attend the marriage of his real brother namely Aakash.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is a convict in case bearing FIR No.330 dated 12.12.2020 under Section 377 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, registered at Police Station, Sadar, District Amritsar. He further contends that marriage of brother of the petitioner is now fixed for 27.10.2023

and that the petitioner may be granted parole so as to enable him to participate in the said function. It is submitted that the petitioner may permitted to be taken to the venue of marriage in police custody and that he is ready to bear all the expenses for making such an arrangement.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Niharika Sharma, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice and on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, submits that she has no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the respondents Authorities to take the petitioner to the venue of marriage ceremony on 27.10.2023 at 10:00 A.M. in police custody after making appropriate arrangement of security. The petitioner shall be brought back to the Jail before 5:00 P.M. on the same day. Expenses for making the appropriate arrangement of security as also for taking the petitioner to the venue of marriage shall be borne by the petitioner.

Pending, misc. application(s), if any shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
