The appellant has filed the present appeal under Section 14-A of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Act') against the impugned order dated 09.10.2023, passed by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Hisar in case FIR No.396 dated 03.10.2023 under Section 506 of IPC and under Section 3(1) (r) and 3(1)(s) of the SC & ST Act at Police Station Hansi Sadar, District Hisar, whereby the anticipatory bail petition filed by the present appellant was ordered to be dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.10.2023 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that the appellant has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the appellant.

In view of the above statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 16.10.2023 is made absolute. The appellant shall continue to join the investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer. The appellant shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 Cr. PC.
