The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in terms of the order dated 30.11.2022, the petitioner has surrendered before the Trial Court and has since been admitted to interim bail by the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar vide order dated 07.12.2022. A copy of the aforesaid order is taken on record as Mark 'A'. He further submits that the petitioner has also deposited his passport and has placed on record a copy of the order dated 09.12.2022 passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, SBS Nagar in this regard. The same is taken on record as Mark 'B'.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. However, the passport shall not be released to the petitioner till the trial concludes. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial except for sufficient cause.
