On 16.10.2023, the following order was passed:-

*“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Bathinda vide which the bail granted by the Trial Court has been cancelled and the bail bonds and surety bonds was ordered to be forfeited to the State pursuant to the nonbailable warrants of arrest have been issued in Complaint No.NACT-794 of 2023 dated 02.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) titled as Gurchetan Singh Versus Gagandeep Singh.*

*The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, he did not appear before the Court on 08.09.2023 on which date the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join proceedings once again.*

*Notice of motion for 24.11.2023.*

*In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one*

*week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Shree Shiv Kanwar Mahasangh Charitable Trust (Regd.) #36A, Near Gugga Marhi Mandir, Maheshpur, Sector 21, Panchkula, Haryana, Bank Account No.5502010000119 IFSC Code BARDBOMDCPAN, Bank of Baroda, Swastik Vihar, Panchkula and on he doing, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.*

*The learned counsel for the petitioner shall place on record a copy of the receipt depositing the amount of Rs.25,000/- as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner.”*

In deference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has since been surrendered and had been admitted to interim bail on 19.10.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

It is expected that the petitioner shall not absent himself from Trial without sufficient cause.
