The instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred for seeking direction to respondent nos.1 and 2 for transfer of investigation in FIR No.43, dated 14.03.2017, under Sections 341/ 342/ 323/ 506/ 120-B, IPC registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda to some higher Officer/SIT, especially in the light of sworn affidavits of the eye-witnesses (Annexures P3 and P4) and the declaration made by the Nagar Panchayat to the effect that no such occurrence took place.

Learned State counsel states that the challan has already been filed before the Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has very fairly conceded that he will be satisfied in case the representation dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P6) is considered and decided within a period of four weeks from today.
