RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of direction to the respondents to enter the name of petitioner in the revenue records as per the order dated 02.04.2013 (Annexure P-1) of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur in Civil Suit No.647 upheld by learned District and Sessions Judge and further upheld by the High Court vide order dated 18.11.2020 in RSA No.3737/2017 in Khewat No.151,152; Khatoni No.191, 192, 193 and 194; Khasra No.28//12/2 min (0-1), 14/1 min (3-13), 17(4-0), 15 min(4-0), 19/2 min(1-16), 20min, 22 min (0-7), 23 min (3-18), 24/1 min (3-04), 24/2 min (0-16), 25 min (4-0), total land measuring 27 kanals 17 marlas situated at Village Nasram H.B. No.327 P.S. Mahilpur Tehsil Garshankar, District Hoshiarpur as the respondent has wrongly entered the name as Faqir Udasi Dharamshal through Deputy Commissioner instead of Faqir Udasi Dharamshal through its Mahant Ranbir Dass. Further prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the respondent to expedite the contempt

proceedings titled as Udasi Dharamshala Vs. Sh. Amarjit Singh and others filed by the petitioner before learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiapur in expeditiously manner or in the time bound manner as soon as possible considering the facts and circumstances as narrated in the present petition, otherwise the petitioner will suffer irreparable loss as the Court has issued notice to all the respondents as in the civil suit who has no relevancy in the present litigation as the present respondents has wrongly entered the name in the revenue records as Udasi Dharamshala through Deputy Commissioner instead of Udasi Dharamshala through its Mahant Ranbir Dass in illegal manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already filed the contempt application (Annexure P-4) which is pending adjudication before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur. He submits that the same be directed to be expedited.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, the present is disposed of with direction to the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hoshiarpur to expedite the proceedings in the contempt application and decide the same in accordance with law.
