Status report by way of an affidavit dated 28.10.2023 of Shri Ashwani Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Economic Offences Wing, Amritsar (additional charge) has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4.

Learned counsel contends that without considering the representation of the petitioners, the final report has been filed by the police and that the version of the petitioners was not recorded.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternative remedy available to them in accordance with law including filing of the complaint before Area Magistrate. If any such complaint is filed and Magistrate finds material to summon the accused under any other provision of law under which the challan has not been filed, the Magistrate will be at liberty to proceed further in accordance with law including Section 210 Cr.P.C.
