After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take all the pleas before the trial Court at an appropriate stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.

From the record, it is apparent that the petitioner is aged about 75 years and is stated to be living alone. Consequently, the personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court shall remain exempted. She is directed to file an affidavit before the trial Court that she will have no objection, in case the proceedings in the present trial are held in the presence of her counsel only and she is also directed to appear before the trial Court, as and when required by the concerned Court. The trial Court may also impose such conditions, as it may deem appropriate. The trial Court is also at liberty to call the petitioner, whenever her presence is required.
