Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned order (Annexure P-5) issued by respondent No.3. Further prayer has been made for directing respondent No.2 to stay the operation of impugned order passed by respondent No.3 for issuing copies of water distribution for outlet pillar No.66550-L of Doda Rajbaha, till the final disposal of revision application bearing No.63-W/A/FDK, diary No.260, dated 22.09.2023 before respondent No.2 and for directing respondent No.3 not to pass any further orders regarding issuance of copies of water distribution for outlet pillar No.66550-L of Doda Rajbaha during the pendency of the revision application bearing No.63-W/A/FDK, diary No.260, dated 22.09.2023 before respondent No.2 and for directing respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioners through their counsel.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have filed the revision petition along with the stay application, which is pending adjudication before respondent No.2. He submits that during the pendency of the same, the Deputy Collector has issued the directions to the Zileदार for fixing the warabandi. He submits that without hearing the grievances of the petitioners by the Revisional Court, the action taken by respondent No.3 is totally illegal.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She, on instructions, has submitted that the revision petition filed by the petitioners is fixed for hearing before respondent No.2 for 20.10.2023.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material on record.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider the grievances raised by the petitioners in the representation dated 06.10.2023 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same expeditiously within a period of four weeks in accordance with law.
