Petitioner (Gurneet Singh @ Deenu) has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.262 dated 25.08.2021, under Section 379-B read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar.
