SURESHWAR THAKUR, J.(ORAL)

1. Disposed of with a mandamus, upon, the B.D.P.O. concerned to forthwith institute an eviction petition against the encroacher(s) concerned upon the petition lands, but preceding therewith, a valid demarcation of the petition lands shall be carried out. If, in the said validly conducted demarcation of the petition lands, encroachment(s) is revealed to be made by the encroacher(s) concerned, thereupon, the B.D.P.O. concerned shall forthwith institute a petition for eviction before the competent authority concerned, who shall on receiving it, shall make a valid speaking decision thereon, within three months of its preferment before him, but, after hearing all affected persons concerned.
