Grievance espoused by the petitioner in the present petition is that the respondent No.3-District Registrar of Societies, Sonipat has appointed an Enquiry Officer to look into the allegations of irregularities on the basis of complaint submitted by respondent No.4-Raj Kumar Jaglan.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners contends that the Enquiry Officer appointed by the District Registrar is friends with the complainant and that they are apprehensive of the Enquiry Officer being unfair and biased in his approach.

Learned counsel, however, concedes that the orders passed by the District Registrar, Firms and Societies, Sonipat, are appealable before the State Registrar, Haryana, under the Haryana Registration and

Regulation of Societies Act, 2012. He thus does not press the instant writ petition, at this stage, so as to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioners under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012.

Needless to mention here that in event of any such appeal/revision being filed by the petitioners before the Appellate/Revisional Authority, an expeditious decision thereupon shall be taken by the competent Authority.

The present petition is disposed of as not pressed accordingly.
