Learned counsel submits that the previous order dated 02.12.2022 has been complied with. He further submits that due to circumstances beyond their control, petitioners No.2 and 4 could not furnish the bail bonds and he seeks time to furnish bonds.

Given above let the petitioners No.2 and 4 comply with the order positively on or before 25.01.2023.

Petition is allowed and interim order dated 02.12.2022 is made absolute. It is, however, clarified that no extension shall be given and in case petitioners No.2 and 4 still fail to comply with the order, this order shall stand vacated qua them.
