The present petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking writ of *Certiorari* for setting aside the office order dated 01.08.2022, Annexure P-9, whereby an amount of Rs.97,149/- was ordered to be recovered from the petitioner's pension without issuing show cause notice to him.

2. Leaned State counsel by referring to the reply filed by respondents No.1 to 4 contends that the impugned office order has been withdrawn under intimation to the petitioner, vide letter No.14481 dated 23.11.2022.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute this fact, and contends that the petitioner may be granted permission to seek refund of the amount that might have been recovered from her pension pursuant to the impugned office order, dated 01.08.2022, before it was withdrawn.

4. In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to seek refund of the amount, if any, recovered from her pension on the basis of office order, dated 01.08.2022, by making appropriate representation, which shall be duly considered and decided in accordance with law. In case any amount is found due to the petitioner, the same shall be refunded within four weeks from the date of filing of representation by her.
