Power of Attorney on behalf of the appellants has been filed today by Mr.Mahipal S. Yadav, Advocate, which is taken on the record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹3,50,000/- (₹Three Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, ₹1,50,000/- each be paid to appellant Nos.1 and 2 and ₹50,000/- be paid to appellant No.3.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit three crossed-cheques i.e. for ₹1,50,000/- each in the respective names of appellant Nos.1 and 2 and for ₹50,000/- in the name of appellant No.3 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 05.01.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.
