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MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J. (Oral)

By way of the instant revision petition, the petitioner-plaintiff No.1 has assailed the order dated 07.07.2022 (Annexure P-13) passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur (for short 'the trial Court') in Civil Suit No.570 of 2016, whereby the evidence of the plaintiffs has been closed while observing that they had failed to conclude the same despite availing sufficient opportunities for the said purpose.

2. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner in the present revision petition, at the preliminary stage and have also perused the file carefully.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that due to some unavoidable circumstances, the plaintiffs could not conclude their evidence

well in time and therefore, they should be granted one more opportunity for this purpose.

4. However, the afore-raised contention is devoid of any force because a perusal of the file reveals that the above-referred Civil Suit pertains to the year 2016 and the issues were framed therein on 16.11.2017 and thereafter, the plaintiffs availed as many as fourteen (14) effective opportunities to conclude their evidence but they failed to do so. Thus, it is quite explicit that the plaintiffs have already availed more than sufficient opportunities to conclude their evidence and hence, they do not deserve any further opportunity for this purpose.

6. In view of the fore-going discussion, this Court is of the considered opinion that the impugned order (Annexure P-13) does not suffer from any illegality, infirmity, irregularity or perversity so as to call for any interference by this Court. Resultantly, the revision petition in hand, being *sans* any merit, stands dismissed.
