JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to issue him passport.
2. Petitioner has been implicated in two FIRs and he has been declared proclaimed person in both the FIRs.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has preferred CRM M-6506-2023 and CRM M-49204-2023 seeking setting-aside of PO proceedings. This Court has stayed PO proceedings in both the FIRs. The petitioner is staying outside the country and to join proceedings before trial Court, he needs passport.
4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that application of the petitioner seeking passport has already been closed, however, the petitioner may

move an application seeking emergency travel document. If he files the said application, it would be processed within two weeks’ from the date of filing.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with the aforesaid arrangement.

6. In the wake of statements of both sides, the instant petition stands disposed of.
