This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 4 not to take coercive steps and not to register the FIR against the petitioner, on the basis of second complaint submitted by respondent No.5-Satnam Singh, on the ground that earlier various complaints were made, which have been found to be of civil nature and finally filed by the authorities after thorough investigation and the petitioner is suffering at the hands of private respondents time and again, who were filing the complaints on the same cause of action before the authorities and the petitioner is dragged into the inquiry proceedings unnecessarily.

During the course of hearing on the last date i.e., 21.02.2023, the Investigating Officer was directed to furnish call details of the number so given by the petitioner in e-mails particularly in the light of the communication via e-mail dated 23.12.2022, which reads as under:-

“I am glad to connect with you today; I would like to summarize your concern regarding incoming and outgoing

call details and the e-bill of your Vi number 9814006225.

I regret to inform you that we are unable to process your request to provide the incoming details of your Vi number as incoming CDRs are shared only with law enforcement agencies. In case you need the CDR details, you would need to route the request through them.

At VI, we are committed to protecting your data and I am sure you will understand and support our data protection policy.

Further, as per your request the E-bill from the month of July 2022 to Dec 2022; has been sent to your registered Email ID on 23-Dec-2022. Kindly check your registered Email ID, Junk, or spam folders, and it will be delivered within 30 minutes. E-bill is sent to you every month on your registered Email ID.

To use your E-bill password, please enter the first four letters of your name (as in our records) and the last four digits of your primary phone number.

E.g., if your name is Sanjeev Mehta and your phone number is 19967899, then your password is sanj7899.

To access your bill:

- *Ensure a PDF viewer is pre-installed on your device, e.g. acrobat*
- *If you are unable to access your E-bill:*
- *Send us a soft copy of your bill from your registered e-mail address*
- *E-bill password is mentioned on the mail body of the E-bill*
- *Send an SMS PASSWORD to 199*
- *The time to receive the password is 15 minutes*

Download adobe acrobat 10.1.8 or above

from <http://get.adobe.com/reader/> and corresponding flash builder to open the E- bill.

Moreover, you can download a summary bill via the Vi

App; the steps are below:

- *Click on "bill history" for the bill summary*
- *Click on "download bill" to view the bill summary*
- *Click on "view bill for the bill summary*
- *Bill summary view will be displayed*

Note: You can request only the last 1-year bill for your Vi number.

You can also get the E-bill at your end:

Send SMS EBILL 3 initial letters of Month to 199 (toll-free), for example, EBILL JAN to 199 (toll-free) and the same will be delivered in 1 hour.

Today, learned State counsel though in possession of the call details in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2023, informs the Court that after inquiry, the complaint has been filed, therefore, the instant petition does not survive any more.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and wants to withdraw the same at this stage.

Allowed as prayed for.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
