1 Today Mr. Rajiv Sharma, Advocate for the respondent has produced communication signed by Chowki Incharge, Lalton Kalan, Thana Sadar, Ludhiana dated 06.11.2023, which as per him has been supplied to him by NCB. The same is in Punjabi. The same is taken on record as mark 'X'. The operative part thereof reads as under :-

“During the enquiry, this fact has been elicited that marriage of Maninder Kaur D/o Jaswinder Singh is fixed for 08.11.2023 and Maninder Kaur has to go abroad on 09.12.2023. That the father of Jaswinder Singh, namely Hari Singh is old aged and except Jaswinder Singh there is no other male member in the household. So it is recommended that accused Jaswinder Singh be granted leave for attending the marriage of his daughter and for other rituals.”

2 By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks interim bail in case bearing crime No.23 dated 06.05.2019 registered under Sections 8/22/29/60 of NDPS Act at Police Station Narcotics Control Bureau,

Chandigarh for a period of 4 weeks starting from 01.11.2023 till 28.11.2023 to enable him to make arrangements for the marriage of his daughter and to attend the same.

3 In view of the communication produced by the respondent-UOI today, the fact with respect to there being marriage of the daughter of the petitioner stands verified and has been found to be correct.

4 In view of above, present petition is allowed.

5 Petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail forthwith subject to the satisfaction of the jail authorities for a period of 10 days. The petitioner shall surrender back on 17.11.2023. During the aforesaid period the petitioner shall bound by the following conditions :-

- (i) *The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.*
- (ii) *The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.*
- (iii) *The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.*
- (iv) *The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.*
- (v) *The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the trial Court.*
- (vi) *The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.*
- (vii) *The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.*
