Present writ petition has been filed for quashing the impugned order dated 21.01.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 09.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.1 being illegal, erroneous, arbitrary and against the mandatory provisions of Northern India Canal and Drainage Act, 1873 as no scheme as per the requirements of Section 30-A and Section 30-B of the said Act has been prepared and published by the authorities below and it is further prayed that the impugned orders may kindly be stayed.

Notice in this case was issued and in response to the same, the State has already filed the affidavit.

Mr. Sunil Kumar, Ziledar, Bathinda is also present in person in Court today.

Learned State counsel, on his instructions, has submitted before this Court that the order has already been implemented.

In view of the above position, nothing more survives for adjudication in the present case. However the petitioners are at liberty to pursue the alternative remedies as available to them in accordance with law in case any cause of action survives.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
