The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0114 dated 03.06.2023 under Sections 62, 65 of the Excise Act, 1914 and later on added offence under Section 77 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2015 and Section 201 IPC registered at Police Station Ranjit Avenue, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 18.10.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 18.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
