1. The petitioner - Charanjit Singh has filed civil revision petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar to decide the HMA Case No.484/2021 titled as Charanjit Singh Vs. Hariday Preet Kaur expeditiously.

2. No purpose would be served by sending notice to the respondent. The status report has been called from the Court concerned which clearly indicates that the case was instituted under Section 13 of Hindu Marriage Act, on 17.03.2021. The written statement has been filed. After framing of issues, the case was adjourned for the petitioner's evidence. In the meantime, the application under Section 24 of Hindu Marriage Act has been disposed of. At present the case is pending for the cross-examination of petitioner and his witness Amrik Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner requested that the learned Principal Judge, Family Court may be directed to dispose of the case expeditiously.

3. I have considered the request. The perusal of status report indicates that the adjournments are given for cross-examination of petitioner and his witness in routine. The concerned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar is directed to dispose of the case expeditiously as far as possible by avoiding unnecessary adjournment.

4. The Civil Revision is accordingly disposed of.
