The petitioner has filed the instant petition before this Court with a prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* to direct respondents No. 2 and 3 to produce the alleged *detenue*, Chander Kanta, before this Court, who had been illegally detained by respondent No. 4 to 7.

In compliance of the last order, the alleged *detenue* Chander Kanta, is present in the Court with respondent No. 6 Lakhpat, her brother. I have talked to the alleged *detenue* Chander Kanta. She submits that she is aged about 16 years and is at present staying with her parents in Phase 11 SAS Nagar Mohali. She further states that she wants to stay with her parents and does not want to go with the present petitioner.

In view of the above said statement made by the alleged *detenue*, Chander Kanta, this Court does not deem it appropriate to pass further orders and the present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
