1. By way of present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing of FIR No.90 dated 03.09.2019 registered under Sections 363, 366, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

2. On 24.02.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

“This is a petition for quashing of FIR on the basis that a compromise has been entered into between the parties.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Harsimranjeet Singh, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.3 and files his vakalatnama and admits to the factum of compromise. Copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of day.

Issue notice to the remaining respondents for 23.04.2020.

In the meantime, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 23.03.2020 or any other date convenient to the trial court/Illaq Magistrate, to get recorded their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements,

learned trial court/Illaqa Magistrate, is directed to send the report regarding the genuineness of compromise and also to intimate whether any PO proceedings are pending against any of the party on or before the date fixed i.e. 23.04.2020.

A copy of this order be sent to learned trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate through fax for compliance.

[3]. In pursuance thereof, it was noticed in the order dated 21.09.2022 that none of the parties have appeared before the Trial Court for the purposes of getting their statements recorded.

[4]. Today also, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that the compromise between the parties has not been matured. Accordingly the present petition is dismissed at this stage with a liberty to petitioners to approach this Court again, in case any further settlement is arrived at between the parties.
