The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.201, dated 17.09.2022, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 326, 148 & 149 IPC (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
