The appellant, through instant appeal is seeking concession of anticipatory bail in FIR No.424 dated 06.10.2022 under Sections 323, 34, 379-A, 380 & 506 of IPC and Sections 3(1)(s) & 3(2)(va) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station I.M.T. Rohtak, District Rohtak.

By order dated 30.11.2022 of this Court, the arrest of the appellant was stayed and the appellant had joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that appellant has been found innocent, thus, present appeal is rendered infructuous.
