The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.265 dated 27.09.2022 under Sections 147, 149, 307, 323, 427, 506, 120-B IPC and 25 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Bhondsi, Gurugram, District Gurugram.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 30.11.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Sombir, Crime Branch, Bhondsi submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 30.11.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 30.11.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
