1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to not remove the banners and hoarding.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2 has pointed out that in the present case, a contract was given to respondent no.3 for putting up boards and hoardings at designated places throughout Kharar and since the same has been done, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the case in case any cause survives.
