The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.119 dated 20.09.2023 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 340, 342 IPC read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 19.10.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A status report dated 06.12.2023 by way of an affidavit of Manjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 19.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
