The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.194 dated 06.06.2022 registered under Sections 25, 54 Arms Act and Sections 379-A, 395, 397, 120-B IPC (added later on) at Police Station Sadar, Palwal, District Palwal.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.02.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
