Petitioner-Anuj Kumar has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to take action on the complaint dated 05.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) submitted by him and general diary report dated 05.05.2021 (Annexure P-5) was recorded in FIR No.66 dated 01.05.2021 (Annexure P-3), under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC was registered at Police Station Nayagaon, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injuries were caused on the person of the petitioner on 25.04.2021 but matter was settled. On the very next day i.e. on 26.04.2021. Co-accused, Sukhmander Singh came and fought with them and an FIR dated 01.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) was registered against the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that on 25.04.2021, Sukhmander Singh started using bad words against them due to which quarrel took place between Sukhmander Singh and ladies. When petitioner intervened to rescue them then

Shakuntala Devi bit the left hand of the petitioner, Neha and Parveen. The police was called, who came at the spot and matter was compromised. The petitioner submitted complaint on 05.05.2021 (Annexure P-4). Only report in General Diary was recorded but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that the petitioner would be content if his representation is decided within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Jaiteshwar S. Bhandari, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, instant petition is ***disposed of*** with the direction to Respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, to look into the complaint (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and take appropriate action required as per law as early as possible, preferably within a period of *two month*.
