MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*) for directing respondent Nos.2 & 3 to transfer the enquiry pending with respondent No.3 to some other police officials not below the rank of Superintendent of Police and to look into the matter (P-1) in accordance with law.

(2) In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit dated 24.01.2020 has already been filed and preliminary objection No.6 of the same reads as under:-

“That the petitioner is in the habit of filing false complaints. The police has filed a kalendra u/s 182 I.P.C. against the petitioner on 11.12.2019 in the learned court which is pending before the learned court of SDJM, Malout. No illegality or

impropriety has been committed by the police in the present matter. The enquiry was conducted fairly and properly. False allegations have been leveled against the police. As such, no cause of action has accrued to the petitioner to file the present petition.”

(3) Perusal of the above extract reveals that after examining the representation dated 14.10.2019 (P-1) of the petitioner, police found the same without any substance and *kalendra* u/s 182 IPC has been instituted against the petitioner.

(4) In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to entertain the present petition. Consequently, the same is disposed off.

(5) However, petitioner would be at liberty to take recourse to the remedy available under law, including challenge to the aforesaid *kalendra*, if so advised.

(6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
