Case called twice, but nobody puts in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Perusal of the case file shows that on the previous date of hearing i.e., 19.10.2023, the petitioner was un-represented.

The note put up by the Registry contradict the stand taken by the petitioner in the main petition, wherein in the head note as well as in para 13, the petitioner has made a declaration that there is no such or similar petition has been filed earlier either before this Court or in the Supreme Court of India and neither any petition is pending in the Court of Sessions, which has been denied by the office note of this Court stating that earlier CRM-M-54348-2022 was filed, which was ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn by this Court on 22.11.2022, meaning thereby, the instant petition is second petition for anticipatory bail.

It is apparent that on that account alone, counsel for the petitioner is consistently not appearing before the Court and the petitioner is un-represented.

In light of the above, the petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
