DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 309 dated 16.10.2022 registered under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar District Amritsar.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners contends that on the directions of this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation and are no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jogender Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation on 19.12.2022 and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 09.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
