1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438, Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
109	30.07.2023	City-I, Malerkotla, District Malerkotla	22 and 29 of the NDPS Act and Section 22 of the Arms Act

2. Upon instructions received from ASI, Kulwinder Singh, State counsel submits that pursuant to interim order dated 20.10.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined and cooperated with the investigation. Still further, he submits that the petitioner, who has clean antecedents, is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the statement of the State counsel, affidavit/reply on behalf of the State is not required.

4. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 20.10.2023 is made absolute subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
