Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.158 dated 11.12.2020, under Sections 302, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Division No.2 District Jalandhar.
