Learned counsel for the appellant submits that he is not pressing the present regular second appeal but wants to make one submission for the consideration of this Court that the appellant who was working as a Guest Lecturer is also entitled for reinstatement in service as per the policy dated 04.03.2020 issued by the Government of Haryana, which has been further amended on 11.05.2022 i.e. after the filing of civil suit by the appellant-plaintiff and the respondents be directed to consider

the claim of the petitioner under the said policy.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Vibha Tewari, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case appellant feels that she is entitled for readjustment as Guest Lecturer under the policy dated 04.03.2020 issued by the Government of Haryana, which has been further amended on 11.05.2022, she can file an appropriate representation before the competent authority and an appropriate speaking order on the same will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case after the decision, it is found that the appellant is entitled for readjustment under the said policy, appropriate relief will be extended to her.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition appeal may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the appellant to approach the competent authority by way of filing an appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
