Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner by the learned JMIC, Sunam vide orders dated 09.08.2022 and 05.11.2022 in case bearing FIR No.175, dated 30.08.2018, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station City Suman, District Sangrur.

Allegation against the petitioner is that in connivance with some other person petitioner had prepared an affidavit by making forged signatures of one Devi Dial and had committed cheating by using that affidavit for taking his vehicle on *superdari* from the Court of SDJM, Sunam.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 30.05.2019 and he was directed to join investigation. Vide order dated 27.08.2019, the Coordinate bench of this Court made the anticipatory bail absolute with the condition that the petitioner would join

the investigation as and when called upon to do so and abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. The challan was presented. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner shifted his residence and did not receive any communication from the Court. The process issued was always received back unserved that the petitioner was not residing at the earlier address.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Jaiteshwar S. Bhandari, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within ten days and move an application in this regard. If such an application is filed, then, he shall be granted ad-interim bail subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
