DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail by way of petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.39 dated 28.05.2023 registered under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149, 506 of the IPC, 1860 (Section 326 of the IPC, 1860 added later on) registered at Police Station Sadiq Faridkot, District Faridkot.

2. It is contended by learned counsel that similarly placed co-accused Manjit Kaur has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 28.08.2023 passed in CRM-M-41553-2023 (O&M) (Annexure P-2).

3. Perusal of Annexure P-2 reveals that attribution of causing injuries are to co-accused Akashdeep Singh. Attribution to another co-accused Mohinder Singh is to have embraced injured Kuldeep Singh from behind. The only attribution to the petitioner and Manjit Kaur, who was allowed bail are that they were present at the time of occurrence.

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4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Parneet Singh Pandher, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent- State.
6. Learned State counsel could not refute the aforesaid contention. It is conceded that case of the petitioner is on similar footing with co-accused Manjit Kaur. Custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel reveals that petitioner is in custody for the last 05 months and 01 day with no criminal antecedents.
7. Having regard to the above facts and circumstances and particularly on the ground of parity, but without commenting anything further on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and petitioner is admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
8. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
