Prayer in this writ petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus for quashing the impugned ex-parte Award dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) whereby the termination of service of workman has been held illegal and improper and reinstatement of workman on the same post and same terms and conditions has been ordered with continuity of service but without back wages.

At the outset, learned counsel for petitioner submits that inadvertently he has not laid challenge to the order dated 18.02.2020 (Annexure P-6) whereby the application for restoration of Award dated 15.09.2017 (Annexure P-1) was dismissed for non prosecution. Learned counsel submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to file fresh one with better particulars and/or to approach the Tribunal below.

In view of aforesaid submissions, the instant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
